Feast of the Sacred Heart: Friday 12th June is the feast of the Sacred Heart and our daily Mass will be at 10am in St Mary's Church Quin.

St Columba's Day: Tuesday 9th June we celebrate the feast of St Columba, one of three patron saints of Ireland, alongside St Patrick and St Brigid. St Columba is associated with Donegal and Derry and is buried in Iona in Scotland.
